

# Hockey doctor now facing 27 sexual assault charges after numerous victims come forward

More victims continue to come forward with allegations against Dr. Zvi Levran, a Farmington Hills doctor accused of sexually assaulting patients.

Levran, who has provided medical assistance to youth hockey organizations in Michigan and Minnesota for the past 20 years, was first charged last October after a 19-year-old man accused him of sexually assaulting him during an exam.

Since then, more victims have accused Levran of sex crimes and the doctor has continued to have charges tacked on.

Levran was arraigned Tuesday on two counts of third-degree criminal sexual conduct and two counts of fourth-degree criminal sexual conduct. His bond is now set at more than \$2.5 million.

He is now facing a total of 27 charges stemming from sex assault allegations.

## Doctor charged after allegedly sexually assaulting teen patient

A Farmington Hills doctor was charged after police say he sexually assaulted a 19-year-old male patient during a medical exam.

Dr. Zvi Levran has been charged with four counts of criminal sexual conduct 3rd degree (force or coercion) and three counts of criminal sexual conduct 4th degree (force or coercion).

According to police, the 19-year-old male victim said he was sexually assaulted during a medical examination at the doctor's home office on October 18, 2022.

Police say Dr. Levran has provided medical assistance to youth hockey organizations in Michigan and Minnesota for the past 20 years.

Dr. Levran was arraigned today and was given a \$100,000 cash/surety bond. If he posts bond, he must have a GPS tether upon release, confined to home but can leave for work/emergencies, may not leave the State of Michigan, and have no contact with minors.

Investigators say they are concerned that other patients may have had similar experiences with Dr. Levran but may not have yet come forward.
